Matthew 19:26 ESV "...With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

Psalm 115:3 ESV "Our God is in the heavens; he does all that he pleases." Job 23:13 ESV "But he is unchangeable, and who can turn him back? What he desires, that he does."

Isa. 46:8-10 ESV "Remember this and stand firm, recall it to mind, you transgressors, remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done..."

1 John 3:20 ESV God "knows everything..."
